ITINERARY:

Day 1: Arrival & Check-in

Arrive in Bali

Transfer to hotel for check-in (Normally check-in time: 14:00hrs & Check- out time: 12:00hrs)

Day 2: Water Sports, Pandawa beach & Uluwatu Temple

Start your day with an exciting 1x Banana Boat ride at Tanjung Benoa, feeling the thrill as you glide across Bali's sparkling waters. Continue to Pandawa Beach, a serene white-sand coastline framed by dramatic limestone cliffs. End the day at the majestic Uluwatu Temple, perched high on a cliff overlooking the Indian Ocean, offering stunning sunset views and a touch of Bali's spiritual charm.

Day 3: Nusa Penida West Tour

Embark on the Nusa Penida West Tour with a pick-up at 06:30 AM. Discover the island's most stunning spots, including the iconic Kelingking Beach with its T-Rex-shaped cliff, the natural infinity pool of Angel's Billabong, the mesmerizing Broken Beach, and the pristine white sands of Crystal Bay — perfect for relaxing or swimming.

REMARKS:

- Indian, UAE, Bahrain, Egypt, Palestine, Qatar, and other 80 Nationalities are eligible for VOA to enter Indonesia (Please check with our team for the details).
- VOA Cost IDR 500,000 (approx. \$ 35 per person) needs to be paid upon arrival at airport in cash (USD, EUR, AUD, or IDR) or by card (Credit or Debit).
- **Starting on 14 February 2024**, Bali will implement a new tourist entrance fee of IDR 150,000 per person for foreign visitors, including children. It is in addition to the existing Visa on Arrival (VOA) fee of IDR 500,000.

The revenue generated from this fee will be allocated to various important initiatives, such as preserving the rich Balinese culture, safeguarding the environment, enhancing tourism services, and upgrading the local infrastructure.

The details concerning the application process and the precise implementation of this regulation are not currently clear. We are closely monitoring for any updates and will provide further information as it becomes available.

SATUSEHAT Health Form for Foreign Arrivals to Prevent Mpox Spread

Starting 30 August 2024, all international travellers arriving in Indonesia are required to complete the SATUSEHAT Health Pass, an electronic self-declaration form available at <https://sshp.kemkes.go.id> or via the provided QR code below.

This form, once filled out, generates a barcode containing the traveller's health and travel information, which will be scanned at airport arrival gates. We recommend filling the form before boarding the flight to ensure a smoother arrival process.

If travellers develop symptoms of Mpox within 21 days of arrival, they are advised to seek medical care and present their SATUSEHAT barcode.

In addition, upon arrival, all travellers will undergo body temperature checks. If a traveller's temperature exceeds 37.5 degrees Celsius, they will be subject to further health screening.

This measure is a preventative step aimed at tracing and limiting the spread of new Mpox variants.

As of today, it remains unclear how this requirement will be enforced and at which entry points, other than Jakarta and Denpasar. We are closely monitoring this situation and will provide updates as new information becomes available.
