HANOI – DA NANG



ITINERARY:

Day 1: Arrival to Ha Noi – Half day city tour (no meal) PVT with guide

Arrive Hanoi airport, pick-up and transfer to hotel in Hanoi.

Check-in the hotel (**check-in is from 2:00 pm, early check-in is not included**)

In the afternoon, we will start a half-day tour of Hanoi. Hanoi has always been a symbol of culture and a source of pride throughout history, bustling Hanoi offers a charming blend of new and old.

The French colonial era has left a legacy of beautiful buildings, with the Old Quarter a fascinating area to explore on foot, etc.

Begin the tour to the Center of Vietnam's government: Ho Chi Minh Mausoleum with Ba Dinh Square where all important events of the country will take place here, opposite Ho Chi Minh Mausoleum is Vietnam Parliament House, and beside the President Palace.

Next place is one of the most beautiful Pagoda of Hanoi named Tran Quoc Pagoda on the island of Hanoi West Lake, Tran Quoc Pagoda is regarded as the most ancient pagoda in Hanoi with its history line dating back to more than 1,500 years, it is A cultural relic - A religious institute - A historical witness.

Continue to Hoan Kiem Lake which is the central point of Hanoi city, and learn more about the history of more than 1000 years of Hanoi's capital; then walk around the Hanoi Old Quarter with small streets & old houses, feel friendly people with typical Vietnamese smiles offer you the true feeling of this capital city, etc. Return to your hotel. Overnight in Hanoi.

Day 2: Ha Noi – Ninh Binh Day Trip: Hoa Lu & Trang An – Ha Noi (B) PVT with guide

Start our day tour to Ninh Binh province where you will come first is **Hoa Lu Ancient capital** situated 7km from Trang An to continue our day tour in Ninh Binh. Upon arrival, ornate temples that worship the Emperors will catch your eyes at first sight. These temples were constructed to honor King Dinh Tien Hoang, King Le Dai Hanh, and King Ly Thai To. On the site, you are told about the story of the first three centralized feudal states of Vietnam: the Ding dynasty, the Le dynasty, and the Ly dynasty.

After the discovery in Hoa Lu, we move to **Trang An**, take a small sampan wooden boat trip slowly rowing through serpentine streams, between the blooming mountains and valleys. The 2.5-hour rowing boat takes you to sacred sites and through some mysterious water caves (there are 3 direction options). Along the way, there are spectacular transitions as you get into a dark cave and a whole new picture appears right in front of your eyes at the exit. Following the boat's schedule, you can drop off the sampan boat to visit some on-land attractions. We can enjoy the fresh air and clean and clear water with underwater grass. Experience the feelings and emotions when we are in the water caves.

Transfer back to Hanoi and overnight in Hanoi.



Day 3: Hanoi – Halong Bay Day Cruise: Otis Cruise 4* - Hanoi (B/L: local food) PVT transfer without guide – SIC Cruise – Guide on cruise

Today we leave Hanoi to **Halong Bay, "Dragon Descending to the Sea"**. Halong Bay is one of the most beautiful and impressive sights in Vietnam. Ha Long Bay has twice been recognized by

UNESCO as a World Natural Heritage Area for its exceptional scenic beauty and one of the world's greatest natural wonders.

Upon arrival, we will embark on a Day Cruise; Start the 5-6 hours journey to explore Halong Bay, passing through thousands of limestone islets; Arrive at Bo Hon archipelago, tour guide will escort you to visit Surprising (Sung Sot) Cave to see a lot of stalagmites and stalactites with different shapes of rock formation, then **go for optional kayaking or bamboo boat rowing in Luon Cave to discover a beautiful lagoon (optional choice/own expense)**. Visit Titov Island, relax on the sandy beach, or climb up to Titov Island peak for a panoramic view of the Bay, etc. After enjoying Ha Long Bay, return to the boat station and transfer back to Hanoi.

Overnight in Hanoi.

The itinerary may vary depending on the specific cruise.

Lunch is included and features local cuisine, organized by the cruise company.

Day 4: Hanoi – Flight to Da Nang – Marble Mountain – Hoi An Ancient Town (B) PVT transfer – Guide in Da Nang

Morning, check-out the hotel, transfer to Airport for flight to Da Nang **(airfare is not included)**

Pick-up and transfer to hotel in Da Nang **(early check-in is NOT included; check-in time is from 2:00 pm)**.

Relax and refresh after the flight.

Afternoon: pick up and visit **Marble Mountain** which is a group of five limestone peaks situated seven kilometers from downtown Da Nang. The five karsts (called Ngu Hanh Son in Vietnamese) are named after the five elements: Kim (metal), Thủy (water), Mộc (wood), Hỏa (fire), and Thổ (earth), you will visit a pagoda in the cave and also get a bird view of the city from the mountain.

Move forward to **Hoi An ancient town**. Hoi An town with its peace and ancient has become one of the most popular tourist attractions that appeal to travelers of tastes and cross over the continents. Exploring Hoi An on foot is one of the best ways to absorb the beauty of this city:

Go to the Phuc Kien Chinese Assembly Hall, a colorful mélange of bright gates, dragon statues, and elaborate rooftops. Get an introduction to ancestor worship while visiting the family altar and watching local devotees making offerings.

You will see remarkably well-preserved old houses Phung Hung Ancient House or Tan Ky Ancient House that have withstood 200 years of weather and war. Learn about the prosperous merchants who used to live in these homes, trading with buyers from all around the world. Especially, you will enjoy art shows at Hoi An Traditional Performing Arts House.



Make a stop at the Japanese Bridge. The bridge spans a small waterway and was constructed more than 400 years ago to connect the Japanese community with the Chinese who lived on the other side of the water. Admire the carvings and paintings inside the bridge, learning about their symbolism and cultural significance.

Additionally, visit some of Hoi An's well-known handicraft shops and artwork galleries. Discover smaller laneways and local neighborhoods, gaining a better appreciation of Hoi An's endless charm.

Return to your hotel. Overnight in Da Nang

Day 5: Da Nang – Ba Na Hills Full Day – Da Nang (B) PVT with guide

Morning, transfer to Ba Na Hills, and arrive at the Cable car station at the foot of Ba Na Mountain. Enjoy the **first leg Cable car**, which achieved two Guinness World Records in 2009, longest non-stop cable car (5,042m) and highest non-stop cable car (1,292m). Sitting in the cabin, in midair, looking upon the endless tree line of the forests, bring you spectacular views of the lush jungle and fairly waterfalls along the way. First, step on **Golden Bridge** which stands 1,400m above sea level in the Ba Na Hills, and extends over the treetops from the edge of a leafy cliff face offering tourists uninterrupted views of the majestic landscape beneath. The Golden Bridge is the latest tourist attraction in Da Nang and has attracted hordes of guests since it opened.

Visit the Le Jardin, remains of French Villas, and Ling Ung Pagoda with 27m high Buddha statue. We then leave the Le Jardin for the second cable car station to visit the top of the mountain and see the remains of old villas. Conquer the Peak of Chua Mountain at the height of 1,487m, and view the whole of Da Nang city under the cluster of white clouds. Leave the Peak of Chua Mountain, and visit the trail of Dreaming Stream, Rainbow Waterfall, Suspension Bridge, Golden Valley, and ruined Opera House. Enjoy 105 free games at Fantasy Park, play with wild monkeys, and take photos, freely then we return to the Cable car station at the foot of Ba Na Mountain and then transfer to Danang. Overnight in Da Nang.

Special note:

- The following tickets/services are NOT included and must be purchased by clients: Wax Statue Museum, entrance to the France Wine Cellar & wine, Roller Coaster game, Climbing game, some prize games, and the 10D movie.

Day 6: Da Nang – Departure (B) PVT airport transfer – No guide

Free at leisure till check out the hotel (**check-out time 12:00noon**) and our driver pick you up at the hotel to transfer to the airport for taking the flight back to your home.

2. **Notice for SIC tour:** Bus will go at convenience route to pick up people in the difference hotels, clients need to be present at hotel lobby (or pick-up venue) on time follow our guidance each day and wait for the bus. Non-refundable in case clients missed the group tour due to late present or sudden cancellation.
3. **Notice for Private tour:** Tour runs follow confirmed program, any missed sightseeing sites due to clients' late will not be compensated.
4. Standard check in time is 2pm; check out time is 12pm; check in before or check out later than mentioned time will be charged follow hotel policy
5. **International remittance will be calculated as per XE rate + Rs. 1/-**
6. No refunds or exchanges can be made in respect of accommodation, meals, sightseeing tours, transport or any other services which are included in the tour prices but not utilized by the tour member.
